1. The Owen Motoring Club Ltd. will organise a National B permit Autotest on Sunday 2nd August 2015 at **Wheels Adventure Park, Birmingham, B8 1AD (OS Map Ref. 139/095872)**, which will be a qualifying round of the Link Up Ltd MSA British Autotest Championship, Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest Championship, the REIS BTRDA Allrounders Championship, the Association of West Midlands Motor Clubs Autotest Championship and the Association of North West Car Clubs Autotest Championship.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA permit number 85855 has been issued
4. The event is open to the following:
 - Members of Owen Motoring Club Ltd.
 - Registered contenders in the Link Up Ltd MSA British Autotest Championship.
 - Registered contenders in the Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest Championship.
 - Registered contenders in the REIS BTRDA Allrounders Championship.
 - Registered contenders in the AWMMC Autotest Championship.
 - Registered contenders in the ANWCC Autotest Championship
5. All competitors must produce a valid competition licence, club membership card, and where applicable, championship registration card.
6. The event is a round of the following championships.
 - Link Up Ltd MSA British Autotest Championship (MSA Waiver of Permit No.)
 - Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest Championship.
 - REIS BTRDA Allrounders Championship
 - AWMMC Autotest Championship
 - ANWCC Autotest Championship
7. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:
Scrutineering starts at 8-30am. Any competitor not signed on at 10.00am may be excluded.
First car starts at 10.15am.
8. The event will consist of 5 classes as follows:
 - A - Saloon cars up to 11ft overall length.
 - B - Saloon cars over 11ft.
 - C – Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars.
 - D - Specials.
 - E – Road Going Series Production Cars.

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations.

Cabriolets must run in the appropriate saloon car class if roof up, or class C or E with the hood down as appropriate

All lengths refer to the overall length which will be determined by the Parkers Car Guide (January 2015 edition), or by manufacturers' specification. Sports Kit Cars eligible for class C will be as listed by BTRDA, which list is available from Helen Perren, Conifers, Cross Butts, Eccleshall, Staffordshire. ST21 6AX.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

Fastest time of the day
Best OMC competitor

an award
The Crimson Dynamo Trophy and replica

First in each class	an award
Second in each class	an award, subject to a minimum of six entries in the class
Third in each class	an award, subject to a minimum of ten entries in the class
Best Novice	an award
Best Junior	an award

A Novice is defined as a competitor who has not won a class award on a National B or higher status Autotest.

No competitor may win more than one award other than Novice and Junior.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these SRs **and closes finally on Friday 24th July 2015**. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Entries can be made, and paid for, on line by going to the Owen Events section at <http://owenmotoringclub.co.uk>. This is our preferred method for entries. Payment can be made by credit/debit card via PayPal or cash. You may enter on line and pay via cheque. Your entry cannot be confirmed until payment has been made. Entries can even be made manually by completing the paper entry form and sending it with payment to the secretary of the event.

The entry fee is £30 for Owen Motoring Club members and £35 for non-Owen MC members. Please make cheques payable to Owen Motoring Club Ltd.

Please check your entry form, as Final Instructions, and Results will be sent out by e-mail, If you require these by post please include a stamped addressed envelope.

12. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40. The minimum is 20. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of these minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

Entries will be selected in order of receipt.

Starting order will be determined by ballot.

Entry fees will be refunded in full if an entry is withdrawn by Monday 27th July. After that a partial refund may be made at the organisers discretion.

14. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the end of the event, and will become final shortly after subject to any corrections or protests.

15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with Blue Book Section C.

16. Details of tests may be sent with final instructions and will be available at signing on. Each driver will have at least two runs at each of the three tests in the morning. In the afternoon all three tests will be combined into one long test. As in the morning each driver will have at least two runs on this test. (last year we managed three attempts at each test). Please ensure you and your car are prepared for this. All runs will count towards the final scores. Timing will be by hand held digital stopwatch to 0.1 second.

The starting signal will be own time after clearance from the test timekeeper. Timing will start when the front wheels cross the second start line and will stop when the front wheels cross the finish line. Vehicles will be required to stop astride the finish line. Order of attempting tests will be at the organisers' discretion.

17. Practising will not be allowed. Competitors may walk the tests before 10am.
18. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organisers.
19. Penalties for all classes other than novices will be:
Line/Pylon: +5 seconds;
Incorrect Test: maximum time, which is the fastest correct class time:- +20 seconds on individual tests, +40 seconds on the combined test.
Time slower than maximum time: maximum time

However, for Novices only, actual times will be displayed subject to a maximum penalty of fastest Class time + 40 seconds on individual tests, +60 seconds on the combined tests, and these times will be used to decide the Novice Award.

20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written, except for the following, which are modified.
 - M4.2 Pylons may be less than 1 metre high.
 - M 17.1 Vehicles need not be licensed for road use as the event takes place entirely on private land.
 - M 13.4 A vehicle may be entered twice to be driven by different drivers, and the responsibility will be shared jointly by both entrants.
 - M23 Incorrect Tests - A test will be deemed to have been performed incorrectly if any line shown on the test diagrams is crossed with both leading wheels in the wrong direction or in the wrong order - which will include stop-astride and drive-through lines, and the manoeuvre is not corrected before crossing the finish line.
