CATTON PARK VENUE



Catton Park will be familiar to many Car Trials competitors as the recent home for Owen Motoring Club's "Ernest Owen Memorial Car Trial" championship round; it is near Walton-on-Trent at map reference 128/206151 (approx postcode DE12 8LN) and is accessible from both the north and south-bound carriageways of the A38, leaving at the Alrewas/Tamworth junction with the A513, departing eastwards. Having crossed the River Trent, turn left (north) immediately after the railway bridge and bear left at the first junction; take care on this narrow minor road.

The Historic Sporting Trial Club has kindly agreed to hold a competitive event for these early-generation sporting trials cars. This promises to be a "must see" for all trials' enthusiasts, or perhaps a "history lesson" for many of us! Start time for this is 10.30 a.m.; after 2.00 p.m. some of these cars and drivers may participate in the "taster" sessions that feature with the other trials disciplines during the day.

Members of the BTRDA Car Trials and Sporting Trials Championships will be holding fun demonstrations in current trials cars, with opportunities to ride or drive in some of these cars for a modest fee. Current or semi-retired competitors, and complete novices, will be able to try their hand on the tests to improve their skills and learn about the capabilities of various cars (including your own!) together with understanding the principles and techniques employed in the sport.

The Sporting Trial element of the day will culminate in a Challenge between two well known World Rally personalities – another "must see" feature which is sure to attract many enthusiasts, be it competitors or spectators!

We want the day, and the dinner that follows, to be a celebration, capturing the essence of "serious fun" that our President, Mike Broad, continues to instil upon us! Former members and former Champions will be made especially welcome.
