

## THE IVINGHOE SPRING TRIAL

# $Sunday \ 6^{th}$ april 2014 additional supplementary regulations

A. The Falcon Motor Ltd. will promote on behalf of Anglia Motor Sport Club Ltd. a National B and Clubman dual permit Car Trial on Sunday 6th April 2014 at Ivinghoe Aston Farm, Near Ivinghoe Aston Beds LU7 9DG. Map reference: - 165/958176.

B. The meeting is held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.

C. MSA Permit Nos. (National B) & (Clubmans) have been issued.

The event is a round of:

BTRDA Car Trial Championship Waver

MSA British Car Trial Championship 2014 /CT/ 0600

D. **The National B** event is open to fully elected members of the organising Club, plus members of the following invited Clubs and Associations: BTRDA Club, The Motor Cycling Club Ltd, non championship National B members of the ACTC.

Plus registered contenders for the 2014 MSA British Car Trial Championship, BTRDA Car Trials Championship and the BTRDA Allrounders Championship 2014, the ACSMC Car Trial Championship 2014, and the ASEMC Car Trials Championship 2014.

**E. The Clubman event** is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club plus the Motor Cycling Club Ltd. Chelmsford MC; Coventry & Warwickshire MC; West Suffolk MC Ltd; Cambridge CC; Eastern Counties MC; Sporting Car Club of Norfolk. AMSC

F. All National B event competitors must produce a valid Club membership card and relevant Competition Licence for the event.

Drivers in the Clubman event must produce a valid Club Membership Card. All National B passengers must produce a valid club membership card.

G. The programme of the meeting will be:-Scrutineering starts at 8:15am. Any competitor not signed on by 9:45am may be excluded. First car starts at 10:00am.

H. Public roads will not be used. There will be at least 6 sections on private land and up to 4 runs at each section, weather permitting. The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.

I.All cars must comply with the MSA Technical RegulationsT11 to T11.14.4.

#### Class 1: 2WD PRODUCTION CARS - CARRYING NO BALLAST

2 wheel drive production cars, first registered on or after to 1 January 1998, taxed for road use, carrying no ballast, no modifications and driven to the venue. It is permitted to fit a sump guard which complete with fittings, must not weigh more than 10kg. Wheels & tyres may be altered in accordance with Blue Book regulations T11.12 & T11.12.5.

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels (see notes 1 & 2)

FWD cars 14 psi FE RWD cars 12 psi RE RWD cars 22 psi

#### Class 2: FWD PRODUCTION CARS

Front wheel drive production cars not eligible for Class 1. Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Notes 1 & 2)

Up to 1200 cc: 12 psi. Up to 1,400 cc: 14 psi. Over 1400 cc: 16 psi

#### Class 3: RWD PRODUCTION AND SPORTS CARS

Rear wheel drive production and sports cars not eligible for Class 1.

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Note 1)

FE Sports cars up to 1800 cc: 16 psi. FE Sports cars over 1800 cc: 22 psi.

RE cars up to 1300 cc: 20 psi RE cars over 1300 cc: 24 psi

FE Saloon cars up to 1800 cc: 14 psi } These cars must have an overall first gear ratio

FE Saloon cars over 1800 cc: 20 psi } which is numerically less than 17. 1

#### Class 4: MODIFIED PRODUCTION CARS, KIT CARS and those not qualifying Class 1, 2, or 3

Production Cars modified beyond Regulations T11.1 to T11.3.1 and modified up to the limits specified in T10 Class 8 (Classic Trials Regulations). Cars in this class will not be eligible for overall placings (Index of Performance). Refer to the BTRDA championship rules for details of full eligibility

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Note 1)

FE RWD cars: 22 psi
FE Kit cars: 24 psi
RE RWD cars: 26 psi
FWD cars: 16 psi

Note 1. Any car fitted with a torque biasing differential or any other form of traction control as catalogued for that car will have tyre pressures set at 4 psi above the specified class pressure.

Note 2. Cars with an overall length of 166 inches and over in classes 1 and 2 may reduce tyre pressures by not more than 4 psi, subject to an absolute minimum pressure of 12 psi.

Note 3. The organisers may include sections which are timed, have split routes, have different starts, and have restart sections or other tests of a similar nature.

Note 4. For Championship scoring purposes, Classes cannot be amalgamated.

Note 5. Classes and tyre pressures are consistent with those of the 2014 MSA British Car Trial Championship.

Note 6. Tie Deciders :- (1) Competitor with the most clean sections. (2) Furthest cleanest (3) Oldest Car

#### J. Awards will be presented as follows: -

1st Overall on Index

1st in each class (subject to 3 starters)

2nd in each class (subject to 6 starters)

3rd in each class (subject to 10 starters)

Best Falcon

**Best Novice** 

The Overall Winner who has the LOWEST INDEX will be awarded the BPI Trophy, to be held until the 2015 event, and a Replica.

No competitor may win more than one award.

Awards will be presented at the end of the event, following publication of the results.
