Supplementary Regulations

1. Kentish Border Car Club in association with Sportingtrials.com will organise a National B permit & Clubsport Sporting Trial at STONEACRE FARM, OTHAM, MAIDSTONE, KENT ME15 8RS on Sunday 1st November 2015

- 2. The Meeting will be governed by the General regulations of the M.S.A. Ltd (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), These SR's and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. M.S.A. Permit number: Applied for
- 4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs. B.T.R.D.A, NPTCC, 750 Motor Club, holding an M.S.A. Competition License valid for the event. (Clubsport class competitors are not required to have an MSA competition licence.) Club membership cards and competition licences, with drivers photograph attached will be inspected at signing on.
- 5. The event is a round of the 2015 MSA Sporting trial Championship and the 2015 B.T.R.D.A. Sporting Trial championship.
- 6. The event will be at STONEACRE FARM, OTHAM MAIDSTONE, KENT ME15 8RS. Public Roads will not be used to link sections. There will be 6 to 8 tests on private land to be attempted 3 or 4 times. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
- 7. Scutineering starts at 9-00 am. First test at 10-30 am.
- 8. Awards to be presented as follows.

Best overall performance of the day:	Driver and Passenger.
Best Performance Red Class.	Driver and Passenger
Best Performance Blue Class	Driver
Best Performance Green Class	Driver
Best Performance by Club Class	Driver

- 9. The entry list opens on the publications of these SR's and closes on the 31st October 2015. The Entry Fee for over 21's is £35.00. The Entry Fee for under 21's and Clubman £25.00 All entries must be completed on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques made payable to Sportingtrials.com and sent to the secretary of the meeting. Late entries will be accepted at an increased fee of £40.00 up to 9.30 on the day of the trial, providing the secretary has been notified. Entry fees will be refunded if the secretary of the meeting is notified by telephone or letter of a competitor's cancellation by 12 noon on the 31st October 2015
