1. The **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd** will organize a **National B** permit Autotest on **Sunday 13th March 2016**. The event will be held at **Curborough** Sprint Course, Fradley, near Lichfield, Staffordshire.
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the **MSA** (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the **FIA**) these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organizing Club may issue for the Event.
3. **MSA** Permit No.93973 has been issued.
4. The event is open to;
 - Fully elected members of the **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd**.
 - Fully elected members of the **BTRDA**.
 - Registered entrants in the **2016 Link Up Ltd MSA** Autotest Championship
 - Registered entrants in the **2016 demon tweaks Direct BTRDA[®]** Autotest Championship.
 - Registered entrants in the **NuCasa BTRDA[®]** Allrounders Championship 2016.
 - Registered entrants in the **ANWCC** Autotest Championship 2016.
 - Registered entrants in the **AWMMC** Autotest Championship 2016.
5. The Event is a round of:
 - The **Link Up Ltd MSA** Autotest Championship 2016
 - The **demon tweaks Direct BTRDA[®]** Autotest Championship 2016
 - The **NuCasa BTRDA[®]** Allrounders Championship 2016. Permit: 49/2016
 - The **ANWCC** Autotest Championship 2016.
 - The **AWMMC** Autotest Championship 2016.
6. All competitors must produce a valid **MSA** Competition Licence, Championship Registration Card and/or Club Membership Card.
7. The program for the Event will be;
 - Signing on commences at **8.30am**.
 - Scrutineering starts at **8.30am**.
 - Any competitor not signed on by **10.15am** may be excluded.
 - First car will start at **10.30am**.
8. The Event will consist of five classes as follows:
 - A.** Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length.
 - B.** All other Saloon Cars.
 - C.** Sports Cars & Sports Kit Cars.
 - D.** Specials.
 - E.** Roadgoing Series Production Cars.

All vehicles in Class **E** must comply with MSA Technical Regulations and be taxed for the public road. A current MOT certificate must be produced at scrutineering: exemption can only be given to vehicles less than three years old and then proof of registration date will be required.

N.B. Cabriolets saloons will run in the appropriate Saloon Car class, or Sports/Kit Car class with hood down. All lengths refer to the overall length, which will be determined by the Parkers Car Price Guide (January 2013 edition) for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification. Kit Cars eligible for classes A, B & C and Sports Kit Cars eligible for class C will be as per the approved **BTRDA® Championship** list, which is available from the acting Championship Secretary:

All cars must comply with **MSA** tyre and vehicle regulations

9. Awards will be presented as follows: -

Fastest Time of Day - **The Harry Yapp Memorial Trophy** & Award.

Best **BTRDA®** competitor - **BTRDA®** crested spoon.

1st in class A - **The Harry Livingston Trophy** & Award.

1st in class B - **The Jet Trophy** and an Award.

1st in class C - **The Harvey Cup** and an Award.

1st in class D - **The Jack Grainger Shield** & Award.

1st in class E - **The Ack-Ack Cup** and An Award

2nd in class (subject to 5 starters) an Award.

1st Novice an Award.

Best performance by a **Hagley** member not qualifying for any of the above awards - **The Garth Weaver Trophy** & Award.

A Novice is defined as a person who has not won **an award** in a National B Status Autotest or higher.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes on **Wednesday 9th March 2016**. The entry fee for the event is **£35.00**. All entries must be made on the official entry form, accompanied by the appropriate fee. All cheques should be made payable to the **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd**.

N.B. Entries will be accepted from Drivers without a current full RTA licence provided they comply with the requirements of **M11**.

12. The maximum entry for the event is **50** and the minimum is **25**. Should the above minimum not be reached the organizers have the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded in full up to the closing date and thereafter at the discretion of the organizers.

14. Provisional results will be posted as soon as possible following the finish of the event.

15. Any protests must be made in accordance with **C5.1.2**.

16. A) Details of Tests will be sent out with Final Instructions.

The definition of test performance and wrong test (M7.8. deleted) is as follows: In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only, whilst a sequence of manoeuvres will be mandatory but not exclusive. A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realizes his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram.

- b) Each driver will have one run at each Test to count for awards.
- c) Timing will be by hand held stopwatch.
- d) The starting signal will be “in own time”.
- e) The order of attempting Tests will be at the organizers discretion.

17. Marking of penalties will be as **M. Appendix 1. Table M.7** except where amended as follows: **(d)** 5 seconds.

18. Practicing will **NOT** be allowed **(M3.5.)**.

19. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organizers.

20. All General Regulations of the **MSA** apply as written except the following, which are modified:

M.4.2. Pylons may be less than 1m in height.

M.17.1. Vehicles need not be taxed or registered as the Event takes place wholly on private property.

M.13.4. A vehicle may be entered twice by two different drivers.

21. Please make sure that your vehicle is in good mechanical condition. In particular, please make sure that your engine is as quiet as possible and complies with the noise requirements of **J5.17**. Also note Tyre Regulations **J5.9**.

22. The Club would like to thank the landowners for their kind assistance in the running of this Event.

Competitors are reminded that the use of List 1B & 1C Tyres is not permitted.
