


JACOBAN TROPHY SPORTING TRIAL
SUNDAY 17th APRIL 2011
FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Thank you for your entry. By Monday evening we had a reasonable but not exciting 26 entries. A dramatic influx of "last minute Henrys" puts the number at a very healthy 39 entries. Attached is a preliminary running list showing your allocated number.
2. Please sign on from 9.00am (and not later than 10.30 am) at the London Car Club tent.
3. Competition licences and Club membership cards must be shown to the Secretary of the Meeting: then proceed to the Scrutineer as soon as possible. The first Hill will commence as soon after 10.30am as is practical, but not later than 10.45 a.m.
4. Score cards will be issued at signing-on: competitors must ensure that their score cards are correctly completed by the marshal in charge of each hill. Efforts to keep them as legible as possible will be deeply appreciated by the scoring team.
5. Marshals' decisions will be final, as judges of fact. Please accept them gracefully!
6. Competitors are asked to return their score cards *as soon as possible* after the completion of rounds to the London Car Club tent, to enable the early completion of scoring, so that you can get home! (*And to collect their score cards again before starting the 3rd round.*)
7. Catering services are not available this year. Toilet facilities will be available.
8. Route instructions - please see map inside cover of S.R.s.
9. **We are always in need of marshals: please bring some willing (or even unwilling) helpers with you.**
10. NOTE: Please respect the landowner's interests: keep to the track from the entrance through several gates to the paddock: leave the gates as you find them.

Park your vehicles on arrival where indicated by the marshals, in order to minimise damage to the paddock.
11. The use of motorcycles on the site is restricted to authorised persons only.
12. *No person may drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.*
13. Parents are asked to ensure that their children do not interfere with the landowner's buildings or property.
14. Addendum: Thomas Bricknell will act as Clerk of the Course. Brian Stapleton as Chief Marshal; Competition Numbers are provisional – please confirm on the day.
