Supplementary Regulations

Directions:

From A39 6 miles East of Camelford – near Otterham Cafe, turn north towards Marshgate. After 500 yards L into gated track to farm. Park in the large paddock provided.

NB. Use of motorcycles on the site is restricted to authorized persons only at the request of the land owner.

Please patronize the catering facilities available that are provided by the landowner and his family with proceeds to local charity. A toilet will also be provided for your convenience.

1. Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd. will promote a National B / Clubman Permit Sporting Car Trial for the David Ayers Trophy at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, Cornwall PL32 9YN on Sunday 18th September 2011. Map Ref: 190/145911.
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Competitions Rules, Standing Supplementary Regulations of the MSA. Incorporating the provisions of the international Sporting code of the FIA, these SRs and any written instructions of which the promoting Club may issue for the event.
3. An MSA permit 66411/66410.
4. The event is open to all full elected members of the organizing Club and any contenders in the BTRDA and Reis ASWMC Sporting Trial Championships.
5. CHAMPIONSHIP contenders MUST provide a valid Competition Licence and Championship Reg. Card. Non-contenders need only a Club Membership Card.
6. Passengers of championship contenders must produce a valid card club membership card for L&NCOMC or BTRDA – special rates available.
7. THE EVENT is a round in the BTRDA, MSA and ASWMC Sporting Car Trials Championships
8. SRUTINEERING will start at 9.00 am
First test will start at 10.30 am
Any Competitor not signed on by 10.00 am may be excluded

9. THE START will be at Trevilla Farm. Public roads will not be used to link sections and there will be 8 sections (weather permitting). The entry will be split into groups starting at different sections.

10. All CARS must comply with the BTRDA / MSA tyre regulations.

11. THE EVENT WILL CONSIST OF 4 CLASSES :

- (1) RED CATEGORY AS PER BTRDA LISTING
- (2) BLUE CATEGORY AS PER BTRDA LISTING
- (3) GREEN CATEGORY AS PER BTRDA LISTING
- (4) Non-Championship Contenders in Cars complying with NTCF or 750 Trials Formula (Clubman).

12. ALL VEHICLES MUST COMPLY WITH MSA Technical Regulations.

13. THE AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS:-

DAVID AYERS TROPHY and Replica - Best Overall Performance
FRANK AYERS TROPHY & Replica - Best Performance in Class 4
CLASS AWARD - for best performance in each class
OTHER AWARDS - will be presented at organisers' discretion.

14. THE ENTRY LIST opens on receipt of Regs and closes finally on Wednesday 14th September 2011.

THE ENTRY FEE is £28.00. All entries must be made on an official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
