Introduction

Once again another year has flown by and though we can hardly believe it, it is time again for the Abingdon Motorsport CAR-nival, this is the 18th year of the event and the 8th year for Dolphin to be putting on the Autosolo.

The CAR-nival Autosolo event counts towards three championships, BTRDA Autosolo, BTRDA Newcomers Challenge and the CMSG Autosolo Championships. It is a popular part of the Abingdon weekend and entries for this event fill up fast so get your entry in quick as entries will be dealt purely on <u>'First come first served basis'</u>.

As a part of The Abingdon Motorsport CAR-nival Weekend (which has raised over £200,000 in 17 years), a large element of the event is based around raising money for The Army Benevolent Fund (Charity No 211645) & The Stowford House Rehabilitation Centre (Charity No 243837). Because of this, you will note that we ask you to make a 'separate contribution' towards the charitable part of the event rather than simply incorporating it into the entry fee. We will accept this element on a separate cheque (Sponsors should note that charitable donations may be tax deductible!). Whilst this may be paid separately, it is in keeping with the other Abingdon events, a MANDATORY part of the entry package. In addition to your direct contributions, we also donate a large proportion of any profits made from the event towards the charities.

Apart from the Solo the CAR-nival weekend also features Sprinting, and a Stage Rally as well as Camping, a large Beer Tent, BBQ and Saturday evening cabaret (Comedian). Anyone wishing to stay for the weekend is welcome although you must appreciate that the facilities are 'as a farmers field'. Camping and caravans are free of charge. Anyone wishing to stay locally will find adequate accommodation at a number of Travel Lodges and Travel Inns all within easy reach of the venue (early booking is recommended for either The Apple Cart (Travel Inn - Didcot) or the Holiday Inn Express (Pear Tree Interchange - Oxford).

We urge you to join us at The Abingdon Motorsport CAR-nival Solo and make a weekend of it by staying over to help or watch the Sunday Stages and enjoy the social side of things with the beer tent and cabaret on Saturday evening.

The whole weekend event has become a 'must do' on the motor sporting calendar.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. Dolphin Motor Club will promote a dual permit Autosolo event on Saturday 7th June 2014, at Dalton Barracks, Abingdon.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the FIA's International Sporting Code); these Supplementary Regulations; and any written instructions that the organisers issue for the event.

MSA permit No. 83381 National 'B' MSA permit No. 83382 Clubman's

- 3. The National 'B' event is open to all members of the organising Club and also to members of the following clubs: BTRDA, CMSGCC, and member clubs of the ASWMC & ACSMC.
- 4. The Clubman's event is open to all members of the organising Club and also to members of the following clubs: BTRDA, CMSGCC, Farnborough District MC, Oxford MC, Middlesex County AC, Club Triumph, CSMA, Witney MC, South East Lotus Owners Club, Basingstoke MC. Bristol MC, Bath MC, Bournemouth MC, Salisbury& Shaftesbury CC and Devices MC
- 5. As per MSA Competitors Yearbook Section (M) 11. Drivers 16, or over without a full RTA Licence may enter the event providing the vehicle used is by definition as a 'touring *(production)* car'.
- 6. Scrutineering and signing on will start at 7.15am, tests start at 09:30am, any competitor not signed on by 9.15am may be excluded.
- 7. Both events will use the same class structure and consist of classes as follows;

Class A. Production saloon cars with engine up to 1400cc Class B. Production saloon cars with engine between 1401cc and 2000cc Class C. Production saloon cars with engine over 2000cc Class D. Mass produced production 2 seat sports cars (open and fixed roof) Including MX5, Lotus Elise, Vauxhall VX220 etc, Class E. Any other road legal car not eligible for classes A-D, (Specials, Caterham, Westfield, GBS, etc.).

- 8. Petrol engine cars with forced induction will in class A and B move up one capacity class. Rotary engine cars will be classed at 1.5 it's normal capacity. Diesel cars with or without forced induction will run in the class corresponding to their engine capacity.
- 9. Production cars are those running with original panel and window materials, although additional panels, e.g. wheel arch extensions, and accessories may be added. They must have full trim and seats although type may be replaced. The original manufacturer's engine type must be fitted in the original position, but it may be tuned. Suspension may be altered within its original configuration. Cars not meeting these requirements are eligible for Class E only.

- 10. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations. All vehicles must be taxed and insured for the public road. A current MOT certificate must be produced at scrutneering: exemption can only be given to vehicles less than three years old, and then proof of date of first registration will be required. Vehicles must compete on road-legal tyres. Tyres from list 1B are not permitted. See list on page 8.
- 11. All vehicles must have been driven to the event via the public highway.
- 12. Championships

The National 'B' event is a qualifying round of BP Motor Bodybuilders Cotswold Autosolo Championship and Meath Engineering (tools) Ltd BTRDA Autosolo Championship.

The Clubman's event is a round of the Demon Tweeks BTRDA Newcomer's Autosolo Challenge.

13. Awards will be presented as follows

First OverallFTDFirst in ClassFTDSecond in Class(subject min. 6 starters in class)Third in Class(subject min. 10 starters in class)First Lady(subject min. 3 starters)First Dolphin Club Member (with full membership, subject to 3 eligible entries)

Classes with fewer than 3 starters may be amalgamated, and no competitor may win more than one award.

14. The entry list opens on publication of these SR's and entries must be received no later than Tuesday day, 3rd June. <u>The standard entry fee is £35.</u>

IN ADDITION TO THE STANDARD FEES, ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A MINIUM £5 CONTRIBUTION TO CHARITY . (Which can be paid for on a separate cheque if required.)

Entries must be on the official entry form, with the correct entry fee.

15. The maximum entry is 54 and the minimum, 20. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, and acknowledged by email/post.

Due to the event format, the same driver cannot enter in more than one car or class, but the same car can be shared by up to two drivers.

If the minimum is not reached, the event may be cancelled, in which case, entry fees will be refunded. If a competitor has to withdraw, and gives reasonable notice, their entry fee will be refunded. Entries withdrawn within less than two days of the event may be subject to a small admin fee, before a refund is made.

Cars will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers.

17. Signing On

All competitors on the event must produce a valid membership card at signing on. Those competitors' who are members of CMSG clubs but who don't have a CMSGCC membership card will have one issued to them on completion of the membership form on the day. CMSG Autosolo Championship Registration is £5.

If 'your' Club is not a member of the CMSGCC, or you are not a member of any of the invited clubs: Dolphin Club Membership, is available. As we are mid year this will be at half our normal rates and will be valid until 31st December 2014.

- 18. Further Instructions concerning Marshalling schedule and running order will be issued at Signing On.
- 19. Cones may be less than 1 metre in height.
- 20. All officials, and competitors while acting as marshals, will be Judges of Fact for the purposes stated in MSA Yearbook Section (M) 26.
- 21. Practising, or driving unsafely anywhere on the site, may result in exclusion. Also, cars must not be driven anywhere on the site by unlicensed or under age drivers, unless competing in accordance with SR 4.
- 22. Provisional results will be published at the end of the event. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Yearbook Section (C) 5.
- Awards Presentation will take place in the Beer Tent at time to be announced during the drivers briefing.
- 24. Final Instructions and directions to the venue will be posted or emailed out and be on the Website, on or around Thursday 5th June.

A current MOT certificate, if the car is more than 3 years old

Your current membership card to one of the invited clubs (If recently joined; cards for new Dolphin members or CMSGCC will be in your paperwork handed out at signing on.).

Your National 'B' or Clubman's Licence as appropriate to your entry.

Amenities on site

There are toilets on the site and in the Autosolo area.

There will be various catering vans providing food and main marquee / beer tent, with BBQ, but these may be a bit of a distance from the Autosolo area, however, the lunch break should give you time to visit these.

There are 24 x7 Fuel Stations at Abingdon within 3 miles of the venue, for your top up to journey home.

Abingdon Airfield, Dalton Barracks is located to the West of Abingdon, adjacent to the A34 and should be accessed via the 'Marcham Interchange (junction A34/A415)' following 'CAR-nival' arrows to the venue.



1. Entrant/Driver
