Supplementary Regulations

1. Glenrothes Motor Sport Club Ltd. Will promote a Clubman / National B status Autotest on Saturday 17th March 2018 at The Scottish Vintage Bus Museum, Lathalmond, Dunfermline, Fife, KY12 0SJ.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of RACMSA Ltd. Incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions of the promoting club may issue.
3. MSA Permit No. 105635 / TBA.
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and also members of clubs which are affiliated to the Scottish Association of Car Clubs and The Association of West Midland Motor Clubs.
5. All entrants must produce a valid club membership card and if applicable a valid Competition Licence.
6. GMSC Membership Costs £10.00 per adult, £2.00 per junior (16 or under) and may be applied for on the day.
7. The programme of the the meeting will be – Scrutineering starts at 10.00 am, and any competitor not signed on by 10.45 am, may be excluded. First car starts at 11.00 am.
8. The event will consist of 7 Classes as follows -
 1. Front wheel drive saloons up to 1400cc.
 2. Front wheel drive saloons over 1400cc.
 3. All specials and sports cars.
 4. Rear wheel drive saloons up to 1400cc.
 5. Rear wheel drive saloons over 1400cc.
 6. Production cars as per MSA Technical regulations F12.1 through to F12.4.
 7. Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – **Must be Standard Production Cars**
9. All vehicles must comply with RACMSA Technical Regulations
10. Child Protection – If competitor is under 18, Entry Form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian, or an appointed representative must be present during the competition and must sign on the competitors signing on sheet. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a representative must be appointed, must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative and must countersign the competitors signing on sheet.

11. Awards will be presented as follows in the event-
1st in Class – an award providing 3 or more start in the class.

19. Each driver will have 2 runs at each test with the better result to count.

20. Timing will be by hand held watches or electronic timing equipment –
whichever is available.

21. The starting signal will be 3,2,1, GO or Lights.

22. The order of attempting test will be in class order.

23. Practising will not be allowed.

24. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the
organisers.

25. Markings and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA
General Regulations.

26. All other General Regulations of the RACMSA apply as written except for the
following, which are modified-
