Supplementary Regulations

- 1 The Hartlepool & District Motor Club will promote a National B/Clubmans Autotest on the 15th September 2019 at the Town Centre (Ramp) car park (map 93/506324), Hartlepool TS24 7SA (nearest postcode).
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) & these Supplementary Regulations & any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3 Motorsport UK permit No's. 113926 & 114142 have been issued for the event.
- 4 The **National B** event is open to all registered competitors in the following championships:-
The Motorsport UK Autotest Championship 2019
Demon Tweaks Direct BTRDA Autotest Championship 2019
BTRDA Allrounders Championship 004/2019.
The **Clubmans** CLASS is open to Members of affiliated ANCC and ANECCC Clubs listed in 21.
- 5 All competitors must produce a valid club membership card, Motorsport UK competition licence and championship registration card as appropriate for the event.
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be:- 9:00 Scrutineering/Signing On starts
10:10 Final signing on time (anyone not signed on, on time will be excluded)
10:30 First test starts. The set of tests in progress at 15:30 will be the final tests or the completion of 18 tests if sooner.
- 7 The event comprises of 7 classes as follows:
 - a) Saloon cars under 11' overall length (inc. Minis with non-original engine and transmission layout driving the front wheels)
 - b) All other Saloon cars
 - c) Sports cars and sports kit cars
 - d) Specials
 - e) Road going series production cars
 - f) Road going kit cars
 - g) Clubmans (see section 21)

All vehicles in Classes E & F must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations and be taxed for the public road. A current MOT certificate must be produced at scrutineering, exemption can only be given to vehicles less than three years old and then proof of registration date will be required. Vehicle registration must be supplied on the entry form. N.B. Cabriolet saloons must run in the appropriate saloon car class with the hood up, or in

appropriate sports car class with the hood down. Kit Cars eligible for classes a & b and Sports kit cars eligible for class c will be as per the approved BTRDA Championship list, which is available from Championship Secretary. Vehicle length will include bumpers whether fitted or not and be determined from Parker's Car Price Guide (2019 edition), if not quoted, manufacturers specification.

- 8 All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations. **Cars will be noise tested to Motorsport UK J5.18.1/CHART 5.18c, this is a Hartlepool Borough Council requirement (J5.17.8).**
- 9 Awards for each event will be presented as follows:-
 - First Overall:- John S Rae Trophy, Champagne, + Replica.
 - First in Class an award + wine (subject to 3 entries)
 - Second in Class an award (subject to 6 entries)
 - Third in Class an award (subject to 9 entries)
 - First Lady an award (subject to 3 entries) Awards are perpetual.
- 10 The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closed finally on the 10th Sept 2019. The entry fee is NAT B £35:00, Clubmans £20. All entries must be submitted on an official entry form plus the entry fee.
- 11 **The Entries must be sent to the secretary**, Bob Clouston, 4 Northwold Close, Hartlepool TS25 2LP. E:Mail cloustonr1@gmail.com
- 12 Minimum entry for the event is 15 and the maximum 50. Class minimums are 3 and the maximums are 20. Should any of the above figures not be met the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, earliest entry will be seeded last in each class and so on. Entry fees may be refunded up until two days before the event subject to notification in writing to the secretary of the meeting.

- 14 Provisional results will be published on our **facebook page** as soon as possible after each test and at the end of the event. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.1.2.
- 15 Details of the tests will be in the final instructions. Each driver will have a number of runs at each test to count for results. Timing will be by timing beam or hand held stopwatches. The starting signal will be on time keeper's instruction. Practicing will not be allowed.
- 16 Competitors will be identified by competition numbers provided by the organisers. "Sponsors advertising must be prominently displayed".
- 17 All other general regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written, except:-

M7.8 Wrong test, is replaced by: A maximum will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres have not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realises his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram.

- 18 Refreshments, McDonalds (PLEASE USE THEM) is within easy reach in the shopping centre and toilets are available just off the Paddock (2 Mins. away).
- 19 All marshals are judges of fact. Any competitor queries **MUST** be addressed to the Clerk of the Course or scoreboard official. (DON'T APPROACH THE MARSHAL)
- 20 **IMPORTANT-** Competitors and family/friends **ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE TEST AREA ONCE THE TEST IS LIVE**. Exempt are competitors in the queue to start the test seated in his/her vehicle and the competitor completing the test.
- 21 The **CLUBMANS** event will be one class (Not qualifying for the 1st overall award & max 10 entries) and is intended as an opportunity for leading club competitors to measure their competence against championship competitors on a championship event. On receiving more than ten entries, selection will be made on recent results and the organiser's decision is final. The invited clubs are :- Hartlepool, Stockton, Whitby & DMC's, Durham AC and Ripon MSC. Alternatively Membership of Hartlepool & DMC can be obtained on the day for £5.
- 22 General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR): Under GPDR we are required to have your consent to Hartlepool & DMC holding personal data such as name, address, e-mail, telephone and other data requested on the entry form. Such data will only be used for the purposes of administering the event and only for the length of time required by the event and to comply with any Motorsport UK regulations. Hartlepool & District Motor Club will be the data controller for the purpose of the GPDR and Data Protection act 2018 and the secretary of the meeting will be the club contact for privacy and data. By signing the entry form you are confirming that you consent to us holding and using your data for this event and that you have also informed other persons that such data supplied on the entry form (e.g. next of kin) will be held by the club and used as above.
