1. The **Whitchurch Motor CLUB** will organize a **National B** permit Autotest on **Sunday 29 September 2019**. The event will be held at **Demon Tweeks, 75 Ash Road South, Wrexham Industrial Estate LL13 9UG**
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the **FIA**) these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organizing Club may issue for the Event.
3. **Motorsport UK** Permit No. Has been issued.
4. The event is open to;
 - Fully elected members of the **Whitchurch Motor Club**
 - Fully elected members of the **BTRDA**.
 - Registered entrants in the **2019 Link Up Ltd Motorsport UK** Autotest Championship
 - Registered entrants in the **2019 demon tweeks Direct BTRDA®** Autotest Championship.
 - Registered entrants in the **Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA®** Allrounders Championship
 - Registered entrants in the **ANWCC** Autotest Championship 2019.
 - Registered entrants in the **WAMC** Autotest Championship 2019.
5. The Event is a round of:
 - The **Motorsport UK** Autotest Championship 2019
 - The **Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA®** Autotest Championship 2019
 - The **Demon Tweeks®** Allrounders Championship 2019.
 - The **ANWCC** Autotest Championship 2019.
 - The **WAMC** Autotest Championship 2019
6. All competitors must produce a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence, Championship Registration Card and/or Club Membership Card.
7. The program for the Event will be;
 - Signing on commences at **8.30am**.
 - Scrutineering and noise test starts at **8.30am**.
 - Any competitor not signed on by **10.00am** may be excluded.
 - First car will start at **10.15am**.
8. The Event will consist of five classes as follows:
 - A.** Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length.
 - B.** All other Saloon Cars.
 - C.** Sports Cars & Sports Kit Cars.
 - D.** Specials.
 - E.** Roadgoing Series Production Cars.
 - F.** Roadgoing kit cars

All vehicles in Class **E and F** must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations and be taxed for the public road. A current MOT certificate must be produced at scrutineering: exemption can only be given to vehicles less than three years old and then proof of registration date will be required.

N.B. Cabriolets saloons will run in the appropriate Saloon Car class, or Sports/Kit Car class with hood down. All lengths refer to the overall length, which will be determined by the Parkers Car Price Guide (January 2013 edition) for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification. Kit Cars eligible for classes A, B & C and Sports Kit Cars eligible for class C will be as per the approved **BTRDA® Championship** list, which is available from the acting Championship Secretary:

All cars must comply with **Motorsport UK** tyre and vehicle regulations

9. Awards will be presented as follows: -

Fastest Time of Day - **The Firefly Trophy and an Award**

Best **BTRDA®** competitor - **BTRDA®** crested spoon.

1st in class an Award.

2nd in class (subject to 4 starters) an Award.

3rd in class (subject to 7 starters) an Award.

1st Novice an Award.

Best lady (subject to 2 starters) an Award.

A Novice is defined as a person who has not won **an award** in a National B Status Autotest or higher.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes on **Wednesday 25th August 2019**. The entry fee for the event is **£35.00**. All entries must be made on the official entry form, accompanied by the appropriate fee. All cheques should be made payable to the **Whitchurch Motor Club**.

N.B. Entries will be accepted from Drivers without a current full RTA licence provided they comply with the requirements of **M11**.

12. The maximum entry for the event is **50** and the minimum is **25**. Should the above minimum not be reached the organizers have the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded in full up to the closing date and thereafter at the discretion of the organizers.

14. Provisional results will be posted as soon as possible following the finish of the event.

15. Any protests must be made in accordance with **C5.1.2**.

16. a) Details of Tests will be sent out with Final Instructions.

The definition of test performance and wrong test (M7.8. deleted) is as follows:

In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only, whilst a sequence of manoeuvres will be mandatory but not exclusive. A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realizes his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram.

- b)** Each driver will have at least 4 runs at each Test to count for awards.
- c)** Vehicles will be identified by numbers supplied by the Organisers.
- d)** Timing will be by hand held stopwatch or by electronic clock and started by the movement of the car.
- e)** The starting signal will be “in own time”.
- f)** The order of attempting Tests will be at the organizers discretion.

17. Marking of penalties will be as **M. Appendix 1. Table M.7** except where amended as follows: **b)** 30 sec **c)** 30 sec

18. Practicing will **NOT** be allowed (**M6.3.**).

19. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organizers.

20. All General Regulations of the **MSA** apply as written except the following, which are modified:

M.6.6. Pylons may be less than 1m in height.

M.5.1 Vehicles need not be taxed or registered as the Event takes place wholly on private property.

M.11.3. A vehicle may be entered twice by two different drivers.

21. Please make sure that your vehicle is in good mechanical condition. In particular, please make sure that your engine is as quiet as possible and complies with the noise requirements of **J5.17**. Also note Tyre Regulations **J5.9**.

22. General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

Under GDPR we are required to have your consent to hold personal data requested on the entry form. Such data will only be used for the purposes of administering the event and only for the length of time required by the event and to comply with any MSA regulations. Whitchurch Motor club will be the data controlled for the purpose of the GDPR and Data protection act 2018 and the secretary of the meeting will be the club contact for privacy and data. By signing the entry form you are confirming that you consent to us holding you data for this event and you have also informed other persons that such data supplied on the entry form e.g. next of kin will be held but the club and used as above.

Competitors are reminded that the use of List 1B & 1C Tyres is not permitted as per M4.7.
