# FOXLEY AUTOTESTS

## SUNDAY 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2019

### **Supplementary Regulations**

1. Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd will organise a National 'B' Permit Autotest on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019. The event will be held at Foxley Estate, Mansel Lacy, Nr Hereford.  
(Map Ref: 149/425456½ / Sat.Nav. systems – Post Code for the Foxley Estate Office is HR4 7HQ).
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. MSA National 'B' Permit No 112584 has been issued.
4. The event is open to:
  - Registered entrants in the 2019 Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship
  - Registered entrants in the 2019 Demon Tweeks *Direct* BTRDA Autotest Championship
  - Registered entrants in the 2019 BTRDA Allrounders Championship
  - Registered entrants in the 2019 Association of West Midlands Motor Clubs Autotest Championship
  - Registered entrants in the 2019 ASWMC Autotest Championship
  - Fully elected members of Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd
5. The event is a round of:
  - The 2019 Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship (MSA Championship Reg. No. )
  - The 2019 Demon Tweeks *Direct* BTRDA Autotest Championship
  - The 2019 BTRDA Allrounders Championship (MSA Championship Reg. No. )
  - The 2019 Association of West Midlands Motor Clubs Autotest Championship
  - The 2019 ASWMC Autotest Championship
6. All competitors must produce for inspection at Signing-On, a valid Competition Licence, Championship Registration Card and/or a Club Membership Card. Where appropriate, a valid Entrants Licence must also be produced for inspection.
7. The programme of the event will be as follows on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March at the Foxley Estate:
  - Scrutineering commences at 8.30am and closes at 10.00am
  - Signing on commences at 8.30am
  - Any competitor not signed on by 10.00am may be excluded
  - Drivers' Briefing will be held at 10.15am
  - The event starts at 10.30am
8. The event will consist of five classes, as follows:
  - (A) Saloon cars under 11ft overall length
  - (B) Saloon cars over 11ft overall length
  - (C) Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
  - (D) Specials
  - (E) Road Going Series Productions Cars
  - (F) Road going kit cars

All vehicles in Class (E) & (F) must comply with MSA Technical Regulations, must be capable of being driven on the road, must be taxed with a valid MOT (if applicable); if a vehicle is less than 3 years old, then proof of registration date will be required. Documents to be produced at Scrutineering.

'Saloons' will include estate cars, hatchbacks and commercial types as appropriate as well as saloon type Kit Cars. Cabriolets will run in the appropriate classes depending on whether the top is raised or lowered,

which may not be changed during the competition. Overall length of the vehicle will include bumpers whether fitted or not.

All cars must comply with current MSA tyre and vehicle regulations.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

Fastest Time of the Day	"The Motoquip Trophy" plus an Award
1 <sup>st</sup> in Class	An Award
2 <sup>nd</sup> in Class	An Award (subject to 6 starters)
3 <sup>rd</sup> in Class	An Award (subject to 12 starters)
Best Novice *	"The Steve Powell Memorial Trophy" plus an Award
Best HMC Member **	"The Doug Moon Challenge Trophy" plus an Award
Best Lady Competitor	An Award (subject to 2 starters)
Best BTRDA Competitor	BTRDA Crested Spoon (to be sent following the event by the BTRDA)

"The Motoquip Trophy", "The Steve Powell Memorial Trophy" and "The Doug Moon Challenge Trophy" all remain the property of Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd and are to be held for 11 months or returned on request by the Organisers.

\*A Novice is defined as a person who has not won an award in a National 'B' status Autotest or higher.

\*\*Best HMC Member is presented to a competing Member not qualifying for any of the above awards and being a fully paid-up Club Member on or before 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

No competitor may win more than one Award, other than the BTRDA Spoon.

Presentation of Awards will take place at Foxley Estate as soon as possible following the results being finalised.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2019. **The entry fee per competitor is £40.00.** All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to "Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd".

Entry fees will be refunded in full up to the closing date only if notice is given in writing, and thereafter at the discretion of the Organisers (H31.1.2(e)).

Entries will be accepted from Drivers without a current full RTA licence provided they comply with M13.

11. The maximum entry for the event, including Reserves, is 50 and the minimum is 25. The maximum for each class is not set and the minimum is 3. Should any of the above figures not be reached, then the Organisers reserve the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt.

14. Provisional results will be displayed throughout the day and will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the event, at the venue.
15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1.2.
16. Details of the Tests will be sent with the Final Instructions and will also be available at Signing On. Each driver will have four runs at each of the four test sites and all runs are to count for results.
  - Timing will be by Hand Held Stop Watches
  - The starting signal will be “in your own time”
  - Order of attempting the tests will be specified by the Organisers at Signing On. All four test sites will commence competition at 10.30am.

The definition of test performance (M7.7) and wrong test (M7.8) is as follows:

*“In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only. Indications of the direction of travel of the competing car when crossing a line, or passing between markers will be mandatory but not exclusive (ignoring ‘shunts’ to avoid markers). A maximum penalty shall be applied if a competitor fails to follow the prescribed test route by passing the wrong side of one or more markers, crosses with both leading wheels a marked test line in the wrong direction, out of the prescribed sequence, or too many/few times, without correcting the mistakes by returning to the point where they deviated from the test diagram, before crossing the test finish line, unless otherwise specified in the SRs.”*

17. Practising will **NOT** be allowed – any competitor performing handbrake turns or the like in the paddock or areas outside of the Test Sites may be excluded (M6.3).
18. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the Organisers.
19. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations (M Appendix 1, Table M.7)
20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written, except the following which are modified:  
M5.1 Vehicles need not be taxed or registered as the event takes place wholly on private property.  
M11.3 A vehicle may be entered twice by 2 different drivers but no driver may drive more than 1 car.
21. Please make sure that your vehicle is in good mechanical condition. In particular, please make sure that your engine is as quiet as possible and complies with the noise requirements of J5.17. Also note Tyre Regulations J5.9 (J5.9.2 1.6mm minimum tread).  
**Competitors are reminded that tyres from MSA Permitted Tyres List 1B & 1C are NOT permitted (M4.7).**
22. Post/Pylons/Markers may be less than 1 metre high (M6.6).
23. Competitors are reminded of Regulation M4.6 : All vehicles should carry a small spill kit complying with J5.20.13.
24. Herefordshire Motor Club would like to thank **Major David Davenport** and **Mr James Davenport** for their co-operation and assistance in organising this event on their private property – competitors are requested to be respectful of the site, Estate personnel and the surrounding area.
