- Knutsford and District Motor Club will organise a National 'B' permit Autotest on Sunday 7th July 2019 at Demon Tweeks, Wrexham Industrial Estate. (Map Ref. 117/382498) by their kind permission.
- The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
- MSA permit number tba
- The event is open to;
 - all fully elected members of the promoting club
 - all registered competitors in the 2019 championships listed in SR5.
 - members of clubs of the ANWCC, WAMC and ANCC.
 - any member of a Regional Association Team.
- The event is a round of the following 2019 championships;
Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship
Demon Tweeks BTRDA Autotest Championship
BTRDA Allrounders Championship
ANWCC Autotest Championship
ANWCC Allrounders Championship
WAMC Junior Challenge

- All drivers must produce a valid competition license and club membership card. Where appropriate championship registration cards and entrant's licences must be produced for inspection.
- The programme of the meeting will be;
 - Scrutineering opens at 08.30hrs
 - Signing on opens at 08.30hrs, any competitor not signed on by 10.15hrs may be excluded
 - First test starts at 10.30hrs
 - The event is scheduled to finish at approx. 16.30hrs
- The event will consist of six classes as follows;
 - saloon cars under 11' overall length
 - saloon cars over 11' 0"
 - sports cars and sports kit cars
 - specials
 - road going series production cars
 - road going kit cars

All vehicles in Class E & F must comply with MSA Technical Regulations and be taxed for the public road. A current MOT certificate must be produced at scrutineering: exemption can only be given to vehicles less than three years old and then proof of registration date will be required.

Saloon cars will include estate cars, hatchbacks and commercial types as well as saloon kit cars. Sports cars eligible for class c will be as per the BTRDA Championship list which is available from the championship secretary, Ann Cook, 10, Harcourt Gardens, Rainham, Gillingham, Kent. ME8 8TG. Email cook.ann@blueyonder.co.uk.

Cabriolet cars must run in the appropriate saloon car class with the hood up or sports car class with the hood down. All lengths refer to the overall lengths, which will be determined by the Parkers Car Guide for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification.

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations.

- Awards will be presented as follows;

a. Fastest Time of the Day	The Tim Sargeant Trophy and Award
b. Best KDMC Member	The MAN F1 Trophy and Award
c. First in class	An Award
d. Second in class (subject to 5 or more starters in class)	An Award
e. Third in class (subject to 10 or more starters in class)	An Award
f. Best Novice	An Award
g. Best Lady	An Award
h. Best BTRDA	A BTRDA Crested Spoon
i. First Inter Association Team	An Award to each team member
j. Second Inter Association Team (subject to 4 teams)	An Award to each team member
k. Third Inter Association Team (subject to 8 teams)	An Award to each team member

Awards b, f, g, are subject to there being at least two eligible entries for each award. No competitor may win more than one individual award except for the BTRDA spoon, which will be awarded by the BTRDA, or a team award. All awards are perpetual except for the Tim Sargeant Trophy and MAN F1 Trophy which are the property of KDMC and must be returned one month before the running of the next event and no later than one year after this event.

- The entry opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally on Thursday 4th July 2019. Individual Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Should the maximum number of entries be exceeded with one delivery then priority will be given to championship entries in the order given in SR5. Late entries will not be accepted. The entry fee is £32. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

11. The Inter Association Team Competition will be contested between teams of three cars representing "The Regional Associations of Motorsports UK" consisting of a saloon Car (Classes A, B or E), a sports car (classes C or F) and a special (Class D). No competitor may be in more than one team. Team entries will be accepted until 09.30hrs on 7th July, provided that the competitor has already entered individually in accordance with SR10. The entry fee for a team is £10.
12. The maximum entry for the event is 45, plus five reserves. The minimum entry is 15. The minimum entry for each class is 3. Should either of the minimum entries not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

15. Marking and penalties will be as M. Appendix 1, table M.7.
16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event and the awards will be presented at the venue.
17. Inter Association Team Results will be calculated by adding together the times of all three team members
18. Details of tests will be sent with final instructions. Three tests will be laid out. Each driver should have a minimum of four runs at each test, all to count for results.
19. Practicing will **NOT** be allowed, any competitor performing handbrake turns or the like in the paddock and surrounding area may be excluded.
20. Competitors will be identified by numbers to be provided by the organisers.
21. Timing will be by handheld stop watches timed to a tenth of a second. Competitors will be told to "start in your own time" once the timekeeper is ready.
22. All other GRs of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are amended;
 - H.31.1.2** Entry fees will be refunded in full up to the closing date if notice is given in writing, thereafter at the organisers discretion.
 - H.35.1.4** A novice is someone who has not won a class or higher award on a National B (or equivalent) or higher status autotest where there were at least three starters in the class.
 - M.5.1** Vehicles need not be licensed for road use (except class e and f) as the whole event takes place on private land.
 - M.6.6** Pylons may be less than 1m in height
 - M.7.8** The definition of a test performance and wrong test is replaced as follows;

"In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only, whilst a sequence of manoeuvres will be mandatory but not exclusive. A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realises his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram."

M.11.3 A vehicle may be entered twice to be driven by different drivers but no driver may drive more than one car

23. All marshals are judges of fact to adjudicate on penalties and their decision is final. A list will be available for examination at the event.
24. Please make sure that your car is properly silenced to comply with **J.5.17**
