CHARLES POLLARD TRIAL 2019

Peterborough Motor Club will hold a National B and Clubmans Sporting Car Trial at Rectory farm ,Uppingham on 29th September 2016. The closing date for receipt of entries will be Wednesday 25th September although earlier entries will be much appreciated. Your entry fee will be reimbursed if you notify the secretary of your inability to compete by Friday 23rd..

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1 The event will be held under the general regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A, these S.R.'s and any other written instructions the promoting Club may issue. The Trial is a qualifying event for the Motorsport UK Trials Championship 2016 and the B.T.R.D.A. Championship.

2. Motorsport UK. Permits for National B and Clubmans events are being applied for.

3. The Trial is open to members of the promoting Club , NPTCC, Sporting Trials.com, Midlands Trials club and BTRDA and contenders for the Motorsport UK Championship. All competitors in the Nat B event must be in possession of an appropriate Motorsports UK Competition License , which must be produced for inspection when signing in. Clubmans competitors must produce a valid club membership card.

4. The Trial will be held near Uppingham at map reference 864984 which is just to the west of the A6003 just south of Uppingham towards Corby. The Lane to the site is opposite the exit from the lay-by situated on the east side of the A6003

5. Starting time 10.30 am. Competitors must sign on 15 minutes before the start time. The Trial will consist of a minimum of three rounds of at least eight sections entirely on private land. Signing on and scrutineering from 9-00 am.

6. Competitors in the Nat B event will be divided into separate classes for cars with independent rear suspension, and for beam axle cars. Each class will be sub divided into Red Blue and Novice classes in line with BTRDA practice. The novice classes may be amalgamated depending on the number of entries. A separate class will be held for Clubmans class entries. Competitors numbers will be allocated by a random draw. Start hills will be identified on competitors' scorecards.

7. Cars must comply with M.S.A. National Trials Car Formula and be passed by the Scrutineer. A brake and Diff test will be made Tyre pressures will be 5 pounds per square inch, unless the Clerk of the Course decides otherwise. Tyre pressures will be checked at scrutineering and spot checks may be made. All tyres from the current Motorsports UK list.

8. Entries will not exceed 45 and the minimum entry will be 20.

Double drives will be permitted if the Secretary is notified before the closing date, and the number of entries does not exceed 30.

9. Closing date for entries is Wednesday 25th September. Entries should be made on the official form and sent to the Secretary of the meeting accompanied by the fee. Alternatively it is quite acceptable to send the entry by E-mail and bring the fee to the event.

15. AWARDS.

Best performance of the Trial (Red class), irrespective of suspension class – The Charles Pollard Trophy & permanent award.

Best performance within alternative suspension class – The Peterborough Motor Club Trophy and a permanent award.

The passenger of both the above will receive an award.

Runner Up in each Red class- an award

Best performance in the IRS Blue class- The Goodwin Cup and an award for the passenger.

Best Performance in beam axle Blue class- The Simon Thornton Trophy and an award for the passenger

Best performance in the Novice class – The Titman Trophy & permanent award.

Passenger - an award

Note. Should a competitor in the Blue or Novice class be the overall winner of the Trial, he will take the Charles Pollard Trophy and the winner of the Red class will be awarded either the Goodwin Cup or the Simon Thornton Trophy or the Titman cup.

COMPETITORS MAY ONLY WIN ONE AWARD

N.B. . Runner-up awards will only be given in a class with six or more competitors.
