

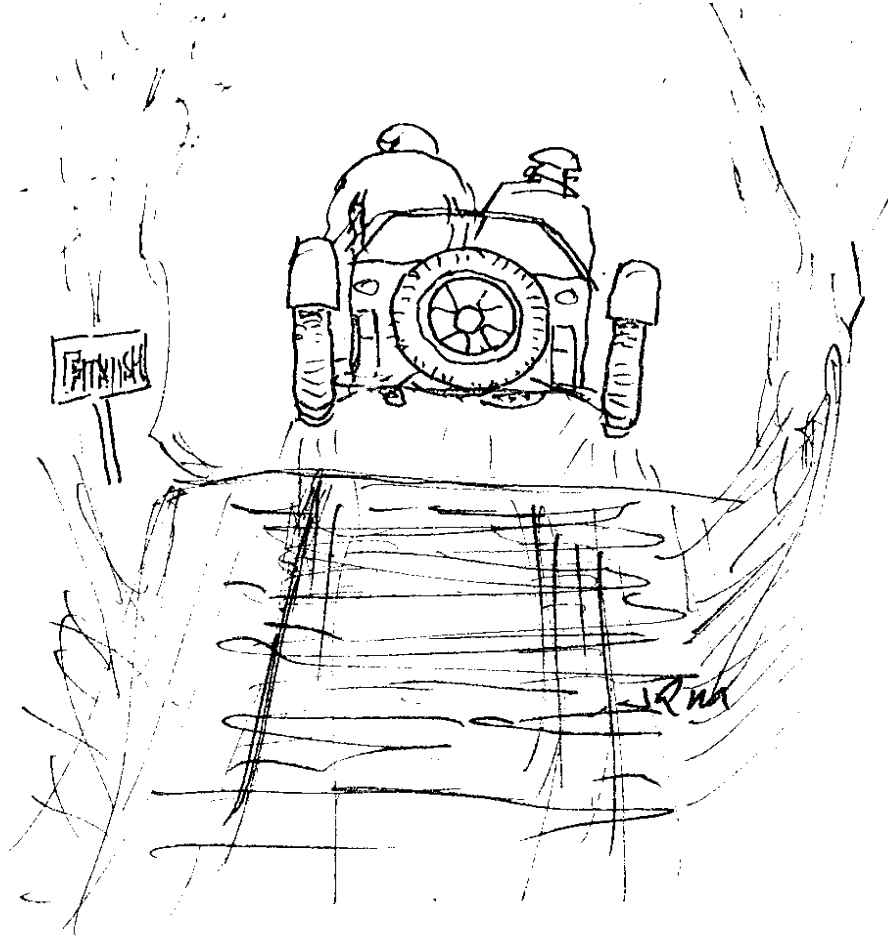

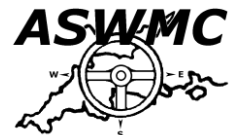

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 The Southsea Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Sporting Trial at Bordean Lane, Froxfield Green, Nr Petersfield, Hants, GU32 1DJ (map reference 197/SU704249) on Sunday 22 March 2020. The event will be jointly promoted by Southsea Motor Club Ltd and 750 Motor Club.
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these SRs and any written instructions the organising clubs may issue for this event.
- 3 Motorsport UK permit number:- 115944
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising clubs or members of one of the following invited clubs:-
BTRDA, Midlands Trials Car Club, Kentish Border, VSCC, HSCC, MCC .

The event counts towards the 2020 BTRDA Sporting Trials Championship (037/2020), The 2020 Motorsport UK British Sporting Car Trial Championship (2020/S/0500), The 2020 ASWMC Sporting Trials Championship (59/2020), The BTRDA Allrounders Championship (permit no 37/2020) and the 750 Motor Club Sporting Trials Championship.

When signing on all drivers and passengers must produce a valid Membership Card from the organising club or one of the invited clubs and a valid Competition Licence as per 2020 Blue Book Section T, page 349, para 3.1.5

- 5 Public roads will not be used to link the sections. There will be 3 rounds of at least 8 sections on private land. The entry will be split into groups, starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.

- 6 All cars will comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations and with the Motorsport UK National Trials Formula or the 750 MC Trials Car Formula – as applicable.
- 7 Awards will be presented as follows:-
Best performance of the day
Best performance in Independent Red Class
Best performance in Independent Blue Class
Best performance in Live Axle Red Class
Best performance in Live Axle Blue Class
Best performance in Rookie Class
Best performance Clubmans Class (**competitors who are not eligible for BTRDA/MSUK championship points**)
Best performance Post Historic
Any perpetual trophies to be returned to Southsea Motor Club by end of February 2021.
- 8 The entry list opens on publication of these SRs and **closes on Tuesday 17 March 2020.**
Entry fee is **£47.50.**

Entries, if submitted by post, must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Entry fees will be refunded if the Entries Secretary is notified of a competitor's cancellation by 12 noon on Friday 20 March 2020.

Entries submitted electronically should be completed on line and emailed to the Entries Secretary by **Tuesday 17 March 2020**.

14 All other GRs of Motorsport UK apply as written except 5.3.4: the running order will not be reversed during the event.

15 Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot.

16 All competing cars must be fitted with an effective silencer

17 **Tyres:**– any tyres listed in 2020 Blue Book Sect L, List 3 complying with relevant championships.

18 No person may drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.

19 **All dogs must be on leads, this is a shooting estate.**
