FOREWORD

This Autotest is being held under the Covid-19 guidelines issued by the Government and Motorsport UK. As the venue is in Wales, we will be adhering to WAG specific Covid-19 rules. Communications are all electronic. Competitors will have to print their own timecard, number, and test diagrams. The Motorsport UK signing on sheet for the event will be sent with entry acknowledgment and must be sent to the Entries Secretary before the closing date. This form includes a declaration that your car is eligible for the event. The scrutineer will only examine selected cars if he/she thinks it necessary. Please read the Covid-19 part of the declaration before signing. We would ask that all competitors keep an accurate record of their times and penalties. The provisional and final results will be computed using the Marshals check sheets and will be sent to each competitor in the week following the event.

You will not be able to apply for the Motorsport UK RS Clubman Status licence at the event so please apply early to Motorsport UK to avoid disappointment. It is your responsibility to have your licence which has to be noted on your entry form. Please ensure that you bring your competition licence, championship registration form and club memberships cards with you for examination if required.

The event requires marshals, but like competitors they must register with the chief marshal and sign the Motorsport UK signing on sheet in advance of the event

The general section has several points specific to the running of the event, please read them before you come to the event.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. BTRDA Limited will organise a Clubmans Autotest on Sunday 3rd October 2021 at Demon Tweeks, Wrexham Industrial Estate (MR 117/382498, Post Code LL13 9UG) with their kind permission.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
3. MSUK Permit _____
4. The event is open to: i) all fully elected members of the organising club,
ii) all registered competitors in the 2021 championships listed in SR5
5. The event is a round of the following 2021 championships
Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship
Demon Tweeks BTRDA Autotest Championship
BTRDA Allrounders Championship
6. All competitors will require a valid 2021 Motorsport UK competition licence of Clubman RS status or higher and a valid 2021 club membership card. Competitors should confirm appropriate championship registration number.
7. The programme of the meeting will be: -
Venue will open to competitors at 8.30 hrs.
Signing-on / Scrutineering will be by prior confirmation of Motorsport UK competitor's signing on declaration, to be received electronically by the Secretary prior to the closing date.
Tests will be available to walk from 09.15hrs.
First test starts at 10.30 hrs.

8. The event will consist of five classes: -
- A: Saloon cars under 11' length
 - B Saloon cars over 11' length
 - C Sports cars and sports kit cars
 - D Specials.
 - E Road going series production cars.

All lengths will be determined by the Parkers Car Guide

All cars in class E must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations and must have MOT and Tax, which must be available for examination if required.

Saloon cars will include estates, hatchbacks and commercial types. Sports cars for class C will be as per BTRDA Championship list.

Cabriolet cars must run either in saloon class with hood up or sports car class with hood down.

9. Awards will be presented as follows: -

a	Fastest time of the day	An Award
b	First in Class	An Award
c	Second in class (subject to 5 or more starters)	An Award
d	Third in class (subject to 10 or more starters)	An Award
e	1 st Novice	An Award
f	Best BTRDA	BTRDA Crested spoon

No competitor may win more than one award, except the BTRDA Spoon award.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these SRs and closes finally at 23:59 Monday 27.9.2021. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. **All entries must be made electronically on the official entry form with the entry fee of £40 being sent by BACS to the BTRDA Account: Santander 09-06-66 BTRDA Ltd 41376536. 11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40 the minimum is 15. The minimum for each class is 3 Should the minimum entry not be reached, then the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

It is planned that each driver will have a minimum of 4 runs at each test.

All times will count for results.

15. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event
16. Final instructions will be sent by e-mail the week prior to the event. They will include:
 - *Details of tests, please print off. There will not be copies available at the event.
 - *Competition number to be printed off and fixed to RHS of car.
 - *Competitors check sheet, please print off and be prepared to fill in during the event.
17. Timing will be by handheld stop watches. The starting signal will be "in your own time". The order of attempting tests will be at the organiser's discretion. The timekeeper will record your time on his check sheet and show you the time and any penalties. You must retain your own timecard for reference. The timekeeper's sheet is the definitive record and will be used to calculate the results.
18. All other GRs of Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following which are amended:
 - a. M6.6 Pylons may be less than 1m in height.
 - b. H30.1.2(e) Entry fees will only be refunded if notice is given in writing before the event.
 - c. H35.1.4 A novice is someone who has not won a class award or higher on a similar or higher status event.
 - d. M5.1 Vehicles need not be licenced for road use (except those in class E) as the whole event takes place on private land
 - e. M11.3 A car may be driven by two competitors.
19. All marshals and timekeepers are Judges of Fact and their decision will be final. A list will be available at the event.
20. General
 - Paddock You will be directed to the paddock area. Please park as directed and observe Social Distancing where possible.
 - Scrutineering. The scrutineer will not come to your car unless he decides it is necessary. You are responsible for self-certifying on the Motorsport UK signing on form the suitability of your car.
 - Walking Tests Please wait until the marshals have set up the tests before walking the tests. Do not forget your own diagrams. Social distancing must be respected while walking the tests.
 - Test procedure Proceed to the first test and queue as directed. Please stay with your car. After the first test proceed to the following tests in order. Where a car is shared the first driver will complete his/ her runs then return to the paddock to change over.
 - Incident Should you have an incident on a test requiring help please stay in the car, if safe to do so, until the marshal approaches you. The driver must indicate to the marshal that they are OK by signalling with a "thumbs up" at the front windscreen. The competitor can exit the vehicle and stand at a suitable distance respecting social distancing. The marshals are responsible for moving a stranded vehicle off the test.
