SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Boundless by CSMA, North East London Group will organise a Clubmans permit Autotest on Sunday 5th September 2021 at the MOTO Cherwell Valley Services, Lorry Park, Bicester OX27 7RD.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit ... 122192 ... has been issued.
4. The event is open to members of Boundless by CSMA, BTRDA, Bedford CC and up to 14 other clubs upon request, and to registered entrants in the following championships:-
Motorsport UK British Autotest, Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest and BTRDA Allrounders.
5. The event is a qualifying round of the following championships:-
 - Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship Permit Number: 2021/A/0700
 - Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest
 - BTRDA Allrounders
6. All competitors must produce a valid 2021 Motorsport UK Competition Licence, Championship Registration card (if applicable) and Club Membership Card.
7. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:-
Scrutineering done by self declaration.
Tests available to walk from 09:00.
The first car will start at 10:30.
8. The event will consist of 6 classes as follows:-
Class A – Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length
Class B – Saloon Cars over 11ft overall length
Class C – Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
Class D – Specials
Class E – Road Going Production Cars (*Must be taxed and have a current MOT*)
Class F – Road Going Kit Cars (*Must be taxed and have a current MOT*)

Cabriolet saloons with the hood down will run in the appropriate sports car class. All cars must comply with the Motorsport UK tyre and vehicle regulations. **Note: 1B or 1C tyres will not be allowed.** All cars MUST be silenced. Overall length will be determined by the Parkers Used Car Guide, or if not given, by the manufacturers catalogue.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:-

Fastest Time of the Day	The Juniper Trophy (*) +	an award
1st in each class		an award
2nd in each class	(subject to 5 starters in class)	an award
3rd in each class	(subject to 10 starters in class)	an award
Best Novice	(subject to 3 such starters)	an award
Best Lady	(subject to 3 such starters)	an award
Best Boundless	(subject to 3 such starters)	an award

All awards are perpetual except named trophies (*) which are to be held for 11 months. No competitor may win more than one award.

10. The entry list opens with the publication of these SR's.

Tuesday 31st August Entries Close.

Latest for copies of club/championship cards and licences to be returned to the Secretary.

Wednesday 1st Sept Event paperwork emailed to competitors and marshals.

The entry fee is £42.

COMPETITORS NOTE: ON THE ENTRY FORM, PLEASE ENTER THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF YOUR ROAD GOING VEHICLE (TOW CAR / VAN OR ROAD DRIVEN COMPETITION CAR), SO THAT YOU ARE NOT CHARGED DURING YOUR STAY AT THE EVENT ON SUNDAY. (This can be amended if needed, by contacting the Organiser). Other vehicles and spectators will have to pay.

11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 45, the minimum 15. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the Organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees will be refunded at organiser's discretion.

13. Results will be on display during the day and provisional results announced as soon as possible following the last finisher. Protests must be made within 15 minutes of the results being announced as provisional, otherwise they will be declared final and the awards presented. Results will be emailed to all competitors.

14. Any protest must be made in accordance with Section C5.

15. (a) Details of tests will be sent with the Final Instructions.
(b) Each driver will have all times to count.
(c) Timing will be by hand held digital timers to 0.1 sec.
(d) The starting signal will be "in your own time".
(e) Order of attempting the tests will be numerical/class order.

16. Practising will not be allowed.

17. Competitors will be identified by numbers sent by the organiser for home printing.

18. Marking and Penalties as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations:-

M9.4 (c) incorrect test +20 seconds
(d) cones 5 seconds (e) lines 5 seconds

19. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following:-

H34.1.4 A Novice must not have won an award on an authorised autotest, other than a team award, since 05/09/16.
M5.1 In consequence of the whole event taking place on private property, vehicles in Classes A-D need not be licensed.
