This event will be organised under the Covid-19 guidelines issued by the Government and Motorsport UK applicable as at the time of the event being held; please refer to the MSUK website for more details.

We would prefer all Entry Forms and Signing On forms to be completed electronically. Whilst documentation is being reintroduced at events, we would like to minimise unnecessary contact at this time for everyone's safety and wellbeing.

Upon receiving an Entry, an electronic Signing-On form will be emailed with the acknowledgement for Competitors to complete and return to the Secretary by the closing date. This form includes a declaration that your car is eligible for the event, however, the Scrutineer will conduct a visual check of all competitors and examine cars if he thinks it is necessary.

Please ensure you bring your 2022 Competition Licence, Championship Registration Card(s) and Club Membership Card with you to the event as spot checks may be carried out.

Competitors' Time Cards will be provided to accurately complete your own scores, in agreement with the Time Marshal – please remember to bring your own pencil/pen! These Time Cards are to be handed in on the day as although Provisional Results will be processed from the Marshals Check Sheets, times will be double-checked against the individual Time Cards after the event and hence Final Results may not be published until the 5th April.

The event requires many Marshals and as it is now permitted, Signing On forms will be available on the day. So if you can persuade any family/friends to help, they will be very welcome.

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Supplementary Regulations

1. Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Permit Autotest on Sunday 3rd April 2022. The event will be held at Foxley Estate, Mansel Lacy, Nr Hereford.
Post Code for the Foxley Estate Office is HR4 7HQ
What Three Words location for the access lane is "visa.shrub.harmony"
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. MSUK Permit No 125571 has been issued.
4. The event is open to:
 - Registered entrants in the 2022 Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship
 - Registered entrants in the 2022 demon tweeks *Direct* BTRDA Autotest Championship
 - Registered entrants in the BTRDA Allrounders 2022 Championship supported by Crystal Images Awards
 - Fully elected members of Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd
5. The event is a round of:
 - The 2022 Motorsport UK British Autotest Championship (MSUK Championship Reg. No. 2022/A/0700)
 - The 2022 demon tweeks *Direct* BTRDA Autotest Championship
 - The BTRDA Allrounders 2022 Championship supported by Crystal Images Awards (MSUK Championship Reg. No. 46/2022)
6. All competitors must have available for inspection if asked a valid 2022 Competition Licence, Championship Registration Card(s) and/or a Club Membership Card. Where appropriate, a valid Entrants Licence must also be produced for inspection.
7. The programme of the event will be as follows on Sunday 3rd April at the Foxley Estate:
 - Scrutineering commences at 9.00am and closes at 10.00am
 - Issuing of Competitors Packs (Signing On) commences at 9.00am
 - Any competitor not signed on by 10.15am may be excluded
 - Drivers' Briefing will be held at 10.15am
 - The event starts at 10.30am
8. The event will consist of five classes, as follows:
 - (A) Saloon cars under 11ft overall length (including Minis with non-original engine and transmission layout driving the front wheels)
 - (B) All other Saloon cars
 - (C) Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
 - (D) Specials
 - (E) Road Going Series Productions Cars

All vehicles in Class E must comply with MSUK Technical Regulations, be capable of being driven on the road, currently registered (no trade plates), taxed, insurance and where applicable in possession of a valid MOT. If a vehicle is less than 3 years old, then proof of registration date will be required. These documents may be inspected on the day.

Note: Cabriolets will run in the appropriate Saloon car class depending on whether the roof/hood is raised or lowered, or Class C or E with the roof/hood down which may not be changed during the competition. All lengths of the vehicle will include bumpers whether fitted or not and be determined by the Parkers Car Price Guide (January edition of the championship year) for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification. A list of approved Sports Kit Cars eligible for Class C will be as per the approved BTRDA Championship list which is available from the Championship Secretary.

All cars must comply with current MSUK tyre and vehicle regulations.

Please note that Electric and Hybrid vehicles are not currently eligible.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

Fastest Time of the Day	"The Motoquip Trophy" plus an Award
1 st in Class	An Award
2 nd in Class	An Award (subject to 6 starters)
3 rd in Class	An Award (subject to 12 starters)
Best Novice *	"The Steve Powell Memorial Trophy" plus an Award
Best HMC Member **	"The Doug Moon Challenge Trophy" plus an Award
Best Lady Competitor	An Award (subject to 2 starters)
Best BTRDA Competitor	BTRDA Crested Spoon (to be presented by the BTRDA at a later date)

"The Motoquip Trophy", "The Steve Powell Memorial Trophy" and "The Doug Moon Challenge Trophy" all remain the property of Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd and are to be held for 11 months or returned on request by the Organisers.

*A Novice is defined as a person who has not won an award in a Clubman status Autotest or higher.

**Best HMC Member is presented to a competing Member not qualifying for any of the above awards and being a fully paid-up Club Member on or before 1st March 2022.

No competitor may win more than one Award, other than the BTRDA Spoon.

Presentation of Awards will take place at Foxley Estate as soon as possible following the results being made provisional and subject to any amendments in the finalised copy.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes on Wednesday 30th March 2022. The entry fee per competitor is £48.00.

If payment is by cheque, make payable to "Herefordshire Motor Club Ltd" and post to the Secretary of the Meeting (details in SR12); to be received no later than the closing date.

Entry fees will be refunded in full up to the closing date only if notice is given in writing, and thereafter at the discretion of the Organisers (H30.1.2(e)).

Entries will be accepted from Drivers without a current full RTA licence provided they comply with M13.

11. The maximum entry for the event, including Reserves, is 50 and the minimum is 20. The maximum for each class is not set and the minimum is 3. Should any of the above figures not be reached, then the Organisers reserve the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt.

14. Provisional results will be displayed throughout the day and will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the event, at the venue.
15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1.2.
16. a) Details of the Tests will be sent with the Final Instructions
b) Each driver will have one run at each Test to count for results
c) Timing will be by Hand Held Stop Watches
d) The starting signal will be "in your own time"
e) Order of attempting the tests will be specified by the Organisers. All test sites will commence competition at 10.30am
f) Passengers are not allowed
- The definition of test performance and wrong test (M7.8 deleted) is as follows:
"In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only. Indications of the direction of travel of the competing car when crossing a line, or passing between markers will be mandatory but not exclusive (ignoring 'shunts' to avoid markers). A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realises his/her mistake, goes back to the point at which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram".
17. Practising will **NOT** be allowed – any competitor performing handbrake turns or the like in the paddock or areas outside of the Test Sites may be excluded (M6.3).
18. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the Organisers.
19. Marking and penalties will be as M Appendix 1, Table M.7.
20. All other General Regulations of the MSUK apply as written, except the following which are modified:
M5.1 Vehicles need not be taxed or registered as the event takes place wholly on private property.
M11.3 A vehicle may be entered twice by 2 different drivers but no driver may drive more than 1 car.
21. Please make sure that your vehicle is in good mechanical condition. In particular, that your vehicle complies with MSUK regulation M4 and in particular J5.13. Also ensure your engine is as quiet as possible and complies with the noise requirements of J5.17. Note the Tyre Regulations J5.9.
Competitors are reminded that tyres from MSUK Permitted Tyres List 1B or 1C are NOT permitted (M4.7).
22. Post/Pylons/Markers may be less than 1 metre high (M6.6).
23. Competitors are reminded of Regulation M4.6: All vehicles should carry a small spill kit complying with J5.20.13.
24. Catering facilities and Toilet facilities will be available at the venue.
25. Herefordshire Motor Club would like to thank Mr James Davenport for his co-operation and assistance in organising this event on his private property – competitors are requested to be respectful of the site, Estate personnel and the surrounding area.
