ILKLEY & DISTRICT MOTOR CLUB LTD. FILTRATE TROPHY CAR TRIAL Sunday 24th July 2022



- 1. Ilkley & District Motor Club Limited will organise the Filtrate Trophy car trial at: The Strid, Bolton Abbey Map Ref 104 / 058 563 on Sunday 24th July 2022.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
- 3. MSA Permits have been applied for.
- 4. The events are open to 2022 British Car Trial Championship contenders, fully elected members of the organising club, fully elected members of the BTRDA. Registered contenders of the ANWCC Car Trial championships.

All competitors must produce a valid club membership card, a valid 2022 competition licence of RS Clubman status and above. Championship registration card at signing on, as appropriate.

- The event is a round of the following Championships: Motorsport UK British Car Trial Championship BTRDA Car Trial and BTRDA All rounders Championship ANWCC Car Trial Championship
- 6. The programme of the event will be: Scrutineering will start at 0900 hrs, / The first car will start at 1000 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 1000hrs may be excluded.
- 7. The event will consist of the following classes:

Class 1: 2WD PRODUCTION CARS - CARRYING NO BALLAST

Two wheel drive production cars, first registered on or after 1st January 1998, taxed for road use, carrying no ballast and having no modifications save as follows. : (a) the fitting of underbody protection weighing no more than 10kg (including fittings); (b) the replacement of wheels in accordance with Regulation T 11.12; (c) the replacement of tyres in accordance with Regulation T 11.12.5. Page 2 Class 1, cont. Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Notes 1 & 2) FWD cars: up to 1,200 cc: 12 psi up to 1,400 cc: 14 psi over 1,400 cc: 16 psi FE RWD cars: 12 psi RE cars: 20 psi.

Class 2: FWD PRODUCTION CARS (Front wheel drive production cars not eligible for Class 1).

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Notes 1 & 2)

Up to 1200cc = 12 psi / Up to 1400cc = 14 psi / Over 1400cc = 16 psi

Class 3A: RWD PRODUCTION CARS and PRODUCTION KIT CARS*

Rear wheel drive production cars not eligible for Class 1. These cars must have an overall first gear ratio which is numerically less than 17:1 and conform to Car Trials regulation for tyres T11.12.6.

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see note 1) FE Sports cars up to 1800cc = 16psi, FE Sports cars over 1800cc = 22 psi, FE Saloon cars up to 1800cc = 14psi, FE Saloon cars over 1800cc = 20psi, Rear Engined cars up to 1000cc = 22psi, RE cars over 1000cc = 26psi.

*Production Kit Cars are not eligible for T11.12 and must only use wheels of the sizes detailed in their MSUK specification which can be found in the Motorsport UK online rescource centre. Production kit cars must comply with T11.12.5 to T11.12.8.

AND

Class 3B: MODIFIED PRODUCTION CARS AND KIT CARS**

Cars (not eligible for Classes 1 & 2) complying with Motorsport UK Regulation T10.

Classes 1-6 and 7(b) and Front Engine Production Kit Cars to approved Motorsport UK specification or modified beyond Car Trials Formula Regulations and up to the limits specified in Regulation T10 Class 7(c) and with the ACTC approved specification (written evidence of such specification to be produced on demand to any event or eligibility official or Championship representative). T10.1 may not apply as MOT is not required when off road. The Car Trials Wheels and Tyres regulations T11.12.5 and T11.12.6 must be complied with.

Minimum tyre pressures in driven wheels (see note 1 below)

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see Note 1) FE Kit cars = 24 psi, FWD cars = 16 psi, FE RWD cars = 22 psi, RE cars = 26 psi

**Compliance shall not extend to T10.9 or T11.12 ie only wheels of the sizes detailed in their Motorsport UK specification of ACTC specification may be used.

In all other cases of rule compliance, Classic Reliability regulations will prevail.

CLASS 8: NON-PRODUCTION CARS

Two wheel drive cars conforming with Regulation T10 Class 8 and subject to limitations set out in Regulation T10.2 to T10.14.5; Car Trial Regulations do not apply.

Cars in this class will not be eligible for overall placings (index of performance).

Minimum tyre pressures on driven wheels: (see note 1) FWD cars = 22 psi / FE RWD cars to ACTC Specification = 22psi, FE Kit Cars = 24 psi / RE cars = 26psi.

CLASSIFICATION OF ANY VEHICLE IN THE EVENT WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANISERS.

ALL VEHICLES MUST COMPLY WITH THE 2022 MSA TECHNICAL REGULATIONS.

General

Note 1 - Any car fitted with a torque biasing differential or any other form of mechanical traction control as catalogued for that car will have tyre pressures set at 4 psi above the specified class pressure.

Any car fitted with an unmodified original equipment electronic traction control system will be allowed without the 4psi tyre pressure penalty.

Note 2 - Cars with an overall length of 166 inches and over in classes 1 and 2 may reduce tyre pressures by not more than 4 psi, subject to an absolute minimum pressure of 12 psi.

Tyres

The following variations to the MSA Regulations apply to all Classes and cars.

T11.12.6 Use of the following tyres is prohibited:-

- a. those having any of the following patterns, inscriptions or manufacturers designations:- 'All Seasons', 'Grip', 'Snow', 'Special Use', 'Town & Country', 'Mud & Snow', 'M+S', 'M.S', 'M&S' or the Three Peaks Mountain Snowflake symbol;
- b. those constructed primarily for off-road use;
- c. those having additional grooves intentionally cut into the tread patterns (post manufacture);
- d. Goodyear All Weather Steel Radial, Goodyear Vector, Pirelli P7, Michelin XRN or Uniband Rally Steel;

T11.12.6.1 Tyres must comply with Regulation L2.1

8. Event Awards will be presented as follows:

1st Overall (on index of performance) – Filtrate Trophy & replica*

Best Performance by a Motorsport UK Trials Championship Contender (on index) – The Motorsport UK Shield

Best Performance by a BTRDA member (on index) – the BTRDA Crested Spoon

Best performance of an IDMC Club member (on index) – Sagar Milburn Trophy*

1ST in Class – subject to 3 entries based on index of performance

2nd in Class – subject to 6 entries based on index of performance

3rd in Class – subject to 8 entries based on index of performance

Novice - subject to 3 entries based on index of performance – Mrs J E Marshall Trophy

Ladies - subject to 3 entries based on index of performance

*No competitor may win more than one award.

9. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally on Monday 18th July 2022. The entry fee is £25.00 for entries received on/before the 18th July 2022. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. A maximum of two entries per vehicle is permitted. 10. The maximum entry for the combined event is 50 and a minimum is 12. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

12. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the event.

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.

- 13. a) There will be at least 10 sections on private land.
 - b) The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.
 - c) One run will be allowed at each hill.
 - d) Practising will not be allowed.
 - e) The organisers of some events may include sections which are timed, have split routes, have different starts, have restart sections or other tests of a similar nature.
- 14. All other GR's of the MSUKA apply as written.

Competition cars, except Class 1 need not have current Vehicle Excise Duty or MOT if required as the event is on private land.

No car may have more than two drivers.

Some markers may be less than 1m in height.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt by the secretary of the meeting.

- 15. A Novice is defined as a competitor who has not previously won a class or higher status award on an equivalent or higher status event for which an MSA permit has been issued.
- 16. A front seat passenger is <u>NOT</u> mandatory for this event. If you start without a passenger you must complete the event without a passenger. If a passenger is carried then that passenger must be carried for the whole event.

The seat alongside the driver must be occupied by a person of at least:

- a) 12 years of age if the drive is over 17 years of age.
- b) 17 years of age and a competitor in the event, holding a valid non-provisional RTA licence, if the driver is over 16 years of age.
- c) 16 years of age if carried in an open vehicle when an observed section is being attempted. The vehicle's rear seats may be occupied by persons of less than 16 years of age.

It is the competitor's responsibility to provide such persons before the event.
