FOREWORD

Knutsford and District are pleased to be invited by BTRDA to run a second championship autotest this year and we have resurrected the KNUTSFORD AUTOTEST with the original trophy going back many years. As many will remember BTRDA ran the last round of the 2021 BTRDA Championship at Demon Tweeks with Mike Sones as Clerk of the Course. That may well have been the same this year had Mike still been with us. Those who were at Mike's funeral will remember the film of him autotesting in his Mini Special, the venue Demon Tweeks in 2002. How appropriate that we should remember him when we visit Demon Tweeks this October, 20 years on.

We hope that Covid will remain of limited concern without the restrictions of the past two years. We will however continue to try and make all administration and communications online, as this seems to be popular with most competitors. The intention is to use the full capability of Timing App Live for both entries and results. The provisional and final results will be computed using Timing App.Live, and you should be able to view the event results live during the day, (competitor timecards and/or the Marshals check sheets may be used to verify). Results will be displayed throughout the event and finalised at the finish.

Please note you will not be able to apply for the MSUK RS Clubman Status license at the event so please apply early to MSUK to avoid disappointment. It is your responsibility to have your license which must be noted on your entry form. Please ensure that you bring your competition licence, championship registration form and club memberships cards with you for examination if required.

The event requires marshals, if they could register with the chief marshal and sign the MSUK signing on sheet in advance of the event, that would be a great help.

- 6. All competitors will require a valid 2022 MSUK competition license of Clubman RS status or higher and a valid 2022 club membership card. Competitors should confirm appropriate championship registration number.

- 8. The event will consist of six classes: -
 - A: Saloon cars under 11' length
 - B Saloon cars over 11' length
 - C Sports cars and sports kit cars
 - D Specials.
 - E Road going series production cars and kit cars

All lengths will be determined by the Parkers Car Guide

All cars in class E must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations and must have MOT and Tax, which must be available for examination if required.

Saloon cars will include estates, hatchbacks, and commercial types. Sports cars for class C will be as per BTRDA Championship list.

Cabriolet cars must run either in saloon class with hood up or sports car class with hood down.
